

## Organisations and forest as self-managing living systems

«In a world where organisations are self-managing living systems, we do not need to force change from the outside. Living systems have an inherent ability to sense changes in their environment and adapt to them from within. In a forest, there is no "upper tree" that plans and dictates changes when the rain fails. The whole ecosystem responds creatively, in the moment. Evolutionary organisations deal with change in a very similar way.» (translated; Laloux, 2017: 128)
